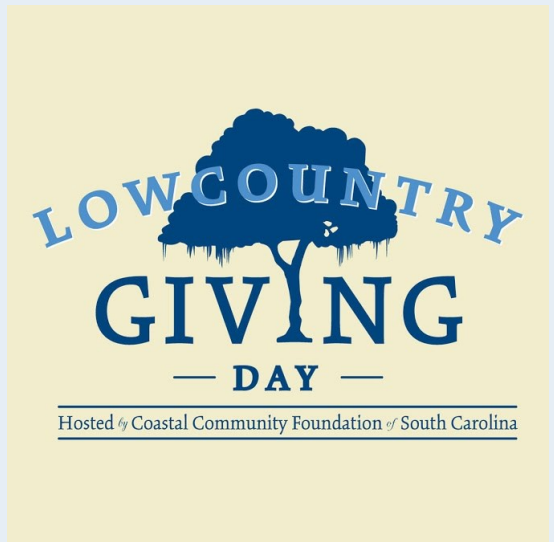
Spring River Cleanups
