PHOTO CONTEST RULES

The third annual Winyah Rivers Foundation (WRF) Photo contest will begin accepting entries February 1, 2010. Our co-sponsors are THE HERRY INDEPENDENT (THI) AND 803 LABS. The goal is to promote the beauty of our local rivers and to raise money for WRF.

Rules for Entering:

- **The contest is open to everyone.**
- **Each contestant may enter as many photographs as desired.**
- **Categories: a) PEOPLE, b) SCENIC, c) WILDLIFE**
Emphasis in judging will be given to photographs that show the splendor and charm of our local rivers.
- **The photographs should have been taken in northeastern South Carolina or southeastern North Carolina and within the past two years.**
- **Each contestant agrees to allow WRF, THI, or 803 Labs to use their entries, without compensation, to promote the goals of the Foundation. This may include exhibition, calendar, or other. All entrants will retain the right to their work.**
- **Entries should be prints; size 8 x 10 inches recommended. Prints will not be returned. Winners will be expected to provide WRF with the original negative or digital file for reproductions and enlargements.**
- **Please tape a piece of paper to the back of your photograph that has your name, address, phone number, and e-mail. Print or type the category in large letters on this piece of paper. Also recommended is a title of the picture and maybe a few words about it. No titles or names on the front of the photo will be accepted.**
- **Awards: There will be approximately \$2500.00 in awards this year. Best of Show & First Place in each category receive plaques, money, free enlargements, and publicity. Second & Third place winners in each category receive similar (just not as much) prizes. There will be a ceremony at the Franklin G. Burroughs—Simeon B. Chapin Art Museum in Myrtle Beach to honor the winners.**
- **Entry fee is \$10.00 per photograph, with check payable to WRF.**
- **Entries should be delivered in person or by mail to: Winyah Rivers Foundation, Center for Marine & Wetland Studies, Coastal Carolina University, 1270 Atlantic Avenue, Conway, SC 29526.**
- **All entries must be received by April 12, 2010.**
