

WINYAH RIVERS FOUNDATION PHOTO CONTEST

WINYAH RIVERS FOUNDATION and THE HORRY INDEPENDENT are sponsoring a photography contest to promote the beauty of the Waccamaw and nearby rivers. The contest is open to all people. It is expected that the photographs will show the splendor and charm of the waterways.

HOW TO ENTER

1. The contest is open to everyone.
2. Each contestant may enter as many photographs as desired.
3. Categories: a) PEOPLE, b) LANDSCAPE/SCENIC, c) WILDLIFE.
4. The photographs must have been taken in the Waccamaw – Pee Dee watershed areas.
5. Each contestant agrees to allow Winyah Rivers Foundation (WRF) and The Horry Independent (THI) to use their entries, without compensation, to promote the goals of the Foundation. This may include exhibition, calendar, or other. Except as used by WRF and THI, all entrants, including winners, will retain the right to their work.
6. Entries should be prints no larger than 8x10 inches. Prints will not be returned. Winners will be expected to provide WRF with the original negative, slide, or digital file so that reproductions and enlargements can be done.
7. Please tape a piece of paper to the back of your photograph that has your name, address, phone number, and e-mail. Print or type the category in large letters on this piece of paper. Also recommended is a title of the picture and maybe a few words about it. No titles or name on front of the print will be accepted.
8. Awards: Plaques for winners plus \$50.00 for best of show and \$25.00 for first place. Ribbons for second and third place. Tentative plans include publishing the winning photographs in THE HORRY INDEPENDENT.
9. Entry fee is \$10.00 per photograph, with check payable to WRF.
